It's totally up to each school on what program is used alongside these books, e.g. a Constitution Bee, essay, test, quiz, etc. To help facilitate things for teachers, I can provide step-by-step instructions on how to implement a Constitution Bee (with test). This program been successfully implemented at Wellington Elementary (near Price, UT) for the last 8 years.

I have Lions members and partnering organizations (attorneys, veterans, etc.) willing to come speak to the classrooms/help out in areas where available.
